The University Diving Safety Manual requires an initial open water check-out dive. The above named applicant for certification must satisfy the specific test requirements of the Diving Safety Officer. These requirements include demonstrating an ability to perform the following:

**INITIAL REQUIREMENTS**

1. Remove and replace SCUBA and face mask at a depth greater than 15 feet.
2. Exchange mouthpiece with partner.
  - (a) Partner with air
  - (b) Partner without air at a depth greater than 15 feet.
3. Make a simulated controlled emergency ascent.
4. Snorkel 1000 feet with SCUBA in position.
5. Surface dive without SCUBA to depth greater than 15 feet.
6. Demonstrate proficiency in diving rescue techniques.
  - (a) Bring unconscious diver to the surface
  - (b) In water mouth-to-mouth resuscitation while towing unconscious diver.
