

MEDICAL MANAGEMENT INFORMATION FOR BSL3 AND SELECT AGENT RESEARCH

BSL-3 and Select Agents at UW

Use the <u>BSL-3/ABSL-3 Medical Management site</u> to access agent-specific information and medical management plans.

Symptom Development

Symptom development is defined as:

- Temperature >100.4°F (38°C), and/or
- Symptoms consistent with infection from research agents, such as cough, shortness of breath, chest pain, general body aches, or skin lesions.

Notification Procedures

If you work in the UW BSL-3 or Select Agent laboratory and develop symptoms, you are required to:

1. <u>Seek medical evaluation:</u>

- During business hours, **call the Employee Health Center at 206-685-1026** and select option 0.
- Outside business hours, call the UW Medical Center Paging Operator at 206-906-8082.
 - > Identify yourself as UW Select Agent/BSL-3 personnel. Request the Campus Health Physician. Be prepared to provide your name and phone number.
 - If no response within 30 minutes, put on a face mask and go to Harborview Medical Center Emergency Department (ED). If absolutely not possible, put on a face mask and go to the nearest ED, and present this card.

2. Notify an EH&S Alternate Responsible Official (ARO) or Responsible Official (RO):

- During business hours, call the Biosafety Office at 206-221-7770.
- Outside business hours, **call Tony Han (ARO) at 206-488-9652** or Zara Llewellyn (ARO) at 425-628-1214 or Katia Harb (RO) at 206-679-3308.
